Mayor Williams explained the Planning and Zoning Committee had met at 8:00am to address a request to zone property to commercial and Resolution 23-04 describes the property. Motion by Husted, second by Morgan to approve Resolution 23-04, motion carried.

Motion by M Anderson, second by Welsh to approve hiring Casey McMillan for a seasonal public works employee for twenty dollars (\$20) an hour. Motion carried.
