
*(All action taken in the following minutes carried by unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.)*

Motion by Patterson, second by M Anderson to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The council asked Coats for an update on the progress of the property at 509 Main Street and preparing it for a beer garden. Coats stated the plan is to remove the front of the building tomorrow and decide if the existing concrete base will be removed or if the concrete will be poured over it. By Tuesday, next week the wall of the Cactus will be opened up for an entrance into the property. The fence on the sidewalk side will be constructed when the concrete is poured either Friday or Monday, with a swinging gate for an entrance. Motion by M Anderson, second by S Anderson to approve the liquor application for the Cactus liquor license to include the legal description of the property where the beer garden is being constructed. Motion carried.

Harley Kirwan asked the council for approval to place a temporary tent behind the Wall Discount Outlet at 507 Main Street in place of the building permit he was approved for. Kirwan indicated he was unable to get the addition built and would like the tent for the Rally only. The council reminded Kirwan his building permit was approved pending an architect stamped blue print for the rafter design and sidewalls were submitted. This paperwork has not been submitted yet and therefore construction cannot begin until it has been turned in and reviewed by the council. Kirwan was also reminded he was not on the agenda and therefore formal action could not be taken at this meeting. The next council meeting is August 6th. It was the consensus of the council not to allow a tent on Main Street or they would be setting precedence.

Mayor Huether declared the meeting adjourned at 7:42pm.
